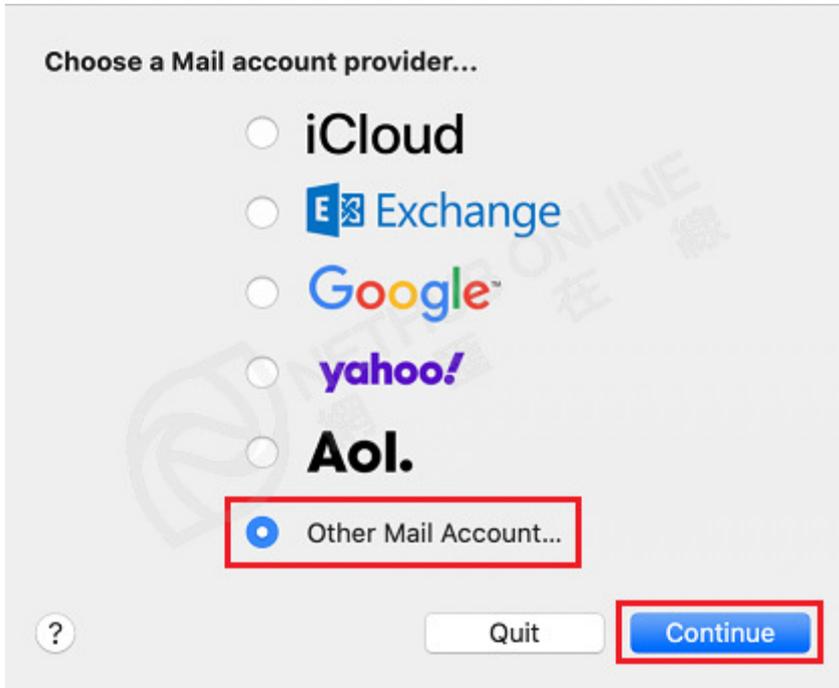


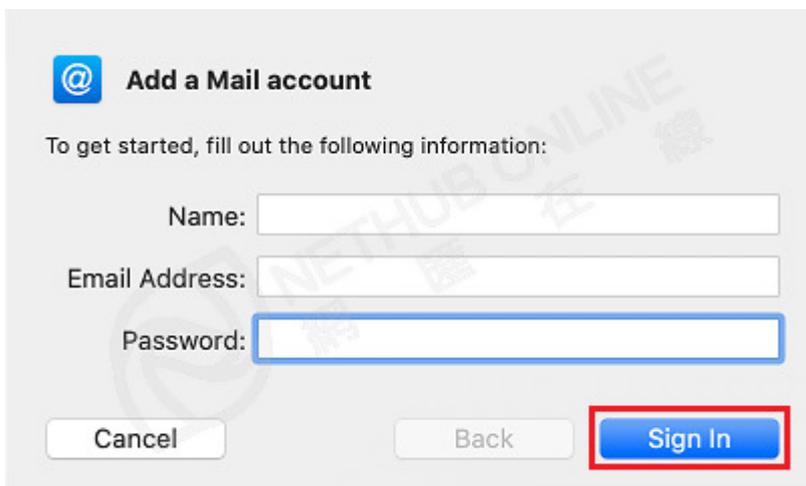
How to setup Email account in Mac Mail

2. Choose <Other Mail Account> and click <Continue>



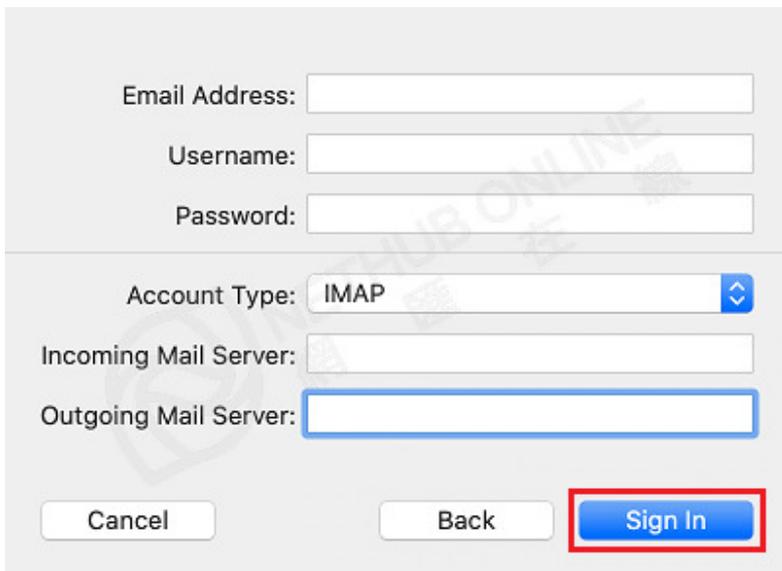
3. Update Settings as below and click <Sign In>

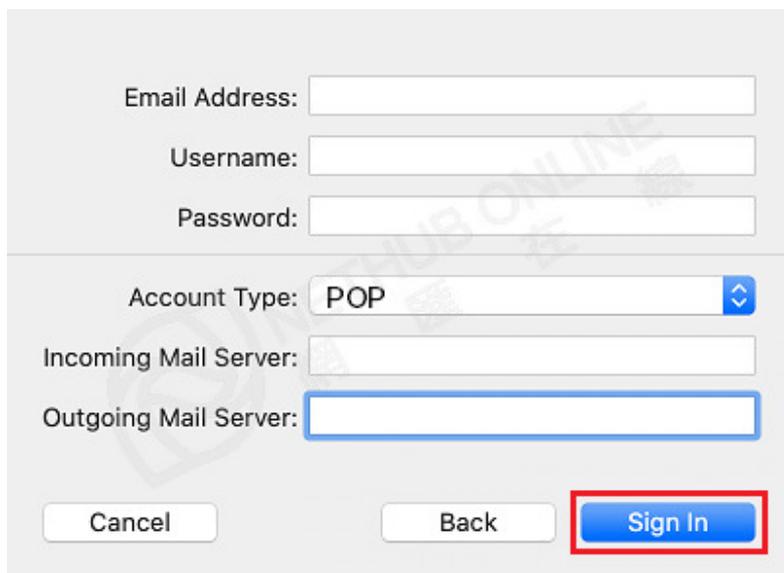

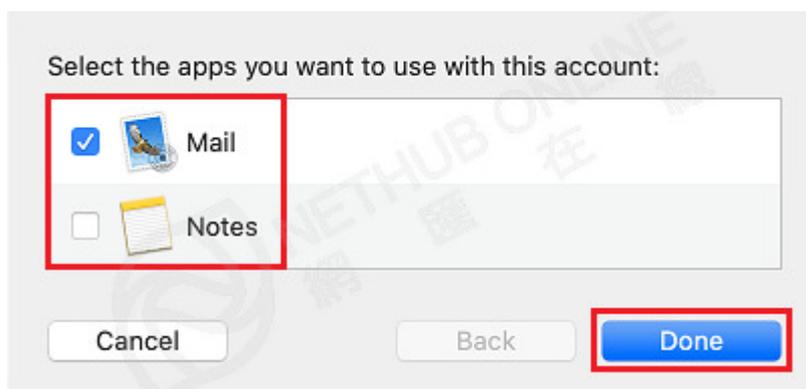
